



## STUDENT INTERNSHIPS

The Hong Kong International Photo Festival regularly recruits students from local colleges and universities to participate in its unique annual Festival. Students who are interested in a career in the art field are welcome to apply. They will get to work closely with the Festival team and participate intensively in the planning, preparation and execution of the Festival exhibitions and events.

Through the Internship, you can expect:

- Gaining insights into the infrastructure and operations of a non-profit art and cultural organisation
- Contributing to community through art
- Meeting people of different backgrounds and disciplines
- Honing practical skills in project management and administration

We welcome all creative inputs - you could be assisting with:

- Exhibition productions and planning
- Editorial and/or translation tasks for catalogue, guidebooks, scripts, captions, etc.
- Research for future projects
- Community and public engagement programmes
- Generating social media content and managing social channels
- Photo and video production
- Marketing campaigns

You will mainly be involved in the following projects / areas:

- Main programme of the annual festival, experiencing the programming of an international art festival firsthand, conceptualising the curatorial theme, fundraising, marketing, art handling, exhibition design and installation, media liaison, and organising opening receptions and outreach events.
- Satellite Exhibitions, making use of public spaces in different districts in Hong Kong, thereby making art accessible to all and connecting different communities and audiences;
- Project Koon Man Space, repurposing a former village primary school to a community-oriented photography infrastructure.

Given the intensity of the internship, we are looking for those who are proactive, observant, self-motivated, meticulous, articulate, open-minded, open to be challenged, friendly, and independent. Those with excellent performance will have a chance to become a regular team member.

The internship duration is flexible. The intern is usually expected to work at least 2 days a week during the academic year and full-time in summers.

A humble daily allowance will be provided throughout the internship.
