

Cantonese-to-English Interpreters (HKIPF 2024)

THE ROLE

Launched in 2010, Hong Kong International Photo Festival (HKIPF) focuses on a different theme in each edition, discussing manifold issues and perspectives through noteworthy photographers and movements. Through a wide range of public programmes, the Festival bridges Hong Kong and international visual practitioners, creating conversations between people and place, past and present, and across borders.

We are currently seeking a team of interpreters to assist with four artist-led talks on the afternoons of 09, 16, and/or 17 November. The talks focus on photography, covering the themes of 'home', 'technology', 'city landscapes', and 'transitory dwellings'. Speakers will be artists from the 2024 HKIPF's flagship exhibition, 'Mega Family: Imagining Home'. Each talk will run for approximately 1.5 hrs and will be supported by at least two interpreters. The Festival will endeavour to provide as much information about the talks as possible prior to the event day.

MAIN DUTY

In this role, you will work under the direction of the HKIPF Project Coordinator and in collaboration with other part-time interpreters to provide simultaneous interpretation from Cantonese to English to English-speaking talk attendees (via headset).

REQUIREMENTS

- Excellent verbal communication in both English and Cantonese;
- Past experience and/or study in translation and interpretation;
- Interest in or knowledge about photography or contemporary art;
- Punctual and responsible;
- Hong Kong Resident aged 18 or above.

To apply, send your CV and cover letter to hr@hkipf.org.hk by 12nn on 25 October 2024. Shortlisted candidates will be contacted for interview. Candidates will be paid an hourly rate of \$100-250/hr (including pre-event prep time), subject to adjustment depending on experience. Headsets will be provided by HKIPF.
